

Dr. Marsela Musabelliu is the Executive Director of the Albanian Institute for Globalization Studies (AIGS), a Tirana-based research center dedicated to promoting interdisciplinary research, publications, and commentaries on current national and international issues.

Her academic qualifications include a Ph.D. in Political Economy from Xiamen University (China), and bachelor's and master's degrees in Political Sciences from the University of Milan (Italy).

Musabelliu has been working with Chinese businesses since 2007 and has over a decade of experience as a Procurement Manager for Asia in one of the biggest corporations in Albania. She transitioned to academia with a specific focus on China studies and has published extensively in peer-reviewed journals since 2016. Her key research areas include China-Albania relations, the Belt and Road Initiative, China-CEEC cooperation, globalization, economic integration, and development studies.

In addition to her role at AIGS, Musabelliu is also a non-resident researcher at the China-CEE Institute (Hungary).
