Summer School "European and Balkan cultural heritage" 10-14.6.2024, Faculty of Philosophy, Skopje

After the successful first Summer School on the cultural heritage of the Balkans at the Faculty of Philosophy in Belgrade in October 2023, the joint Summer School will now move to Skopje, where students will have the opportunity to learn about different disciplinary and national approaches to the study of the cultural, religious and political heritage of the Balkans. The emphasis will of course be on the Macedonian and Serbian heritage, however, the lectures will include the history of the wider Balkan tradition, as well as, of course, the analysis of contemporary challenges that societies in this area are facing with. Also, the thematic framework will certainly include a review of the general European context in which we place the dynamics of relations within the Balkan cultures. The Summer Schools are the result of intensive and successful cooperation between the Faculty of Philosophy in Skopje and the Faculty of Philosophy in Belgrade.

The lecturers at the Summer School are professors from the Faculty of Philosophy in Belgrade and the Faculty of Philosophy in Skopje, who will introduce students to different perspectives and experiences through a series of *ex cathedra* lectures and interactive workshops. The participants of the Summer School will have the opportunity to gain knowledge about various classical theoretical frameworks and methodologies for the study of cultural heritage from the perspective of archaeology, art history, philosophy, sociology, anthropology, classics and history, but also to become familiar with the most important current academic debates related to the study cultures in the Balkans.

The participants of the Summer School are students of bachelor studies as well as master and doctoral students of the Faculty of Philosophy in Skopje and Belgrade from all study programs. The transportation and accommodation of the students for the needs of the Summer School will be covered by both faculties. Selected students attending the summer school will receive a certificate of participation in the Summer School.
